ECCR has, along with several other NGO:s, required access to judicial proceedings reviewing the legitimacy of the behavior of the State and its appointed instruments in the matters of the environmental radioactive contamination of the Baltic Sea and its effect on the Human Rights and the Environment.

The Chancellor of Justice is appointed by the Swedish Government. A detailed description of the duties of the Chancellor of Justice is set forth in two legal instruments; the Act (1975:1339) concerning the supervision exercised by the Chancellor of Justice and the Ordinance (1975:1345) concerning the duties of the Chancellor of Justice.

The Chancellor of Justice is a Swedish, national supervisory authority, responsible mainly for supervising the lawfulness of the authorities in Sweden. The Chancellor of Justice cannot grant access to judicial proceedings.

Your request will not lead to any further action by the Chancellor of Justice.
